**ALUMNI MUSICAL EXCELLENCE
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

The Alumni Musical Excellence Scholarship is awarded to a senior band student in the Tarpon Springs High School Leadership Conservatory for the Arts. Applicants for this scholarship must continue their study as a music major at a college or music conservatory. The scholarship will be presented at the annual Conservatory Banquet, and is intended to fund the winners musical pursuits, to include tuition, books, music instruments and/or equipment.

This scholarship was initiated in 2018 by Adrian Holton, a Class of 2002 alumnus. Adrian is a professional musician previously in the United States Air Force Band and currently performs as Principal Trumpet with the Colorado Springs Philharmonic. The scholarship is intended to help instrumental music students further their music education and pursue a music career. It is funded by contributions from Tarpon Springs High School Band alumni.

Qualifications:

Participation: Senior instrumental students planning to continue their studies as a music major at a college or music conservatory.

Essay: Please submit an essay not exceed two pages that answers the following questions:

- What college or music conservatory will you attend to pursue your undergraduate music degree, and what will be your major?
- Where do you see yourself in 10 years, both personally and professionally?
- What will it take to get there and/or what are some logical steps you may take along the way?
- How will you spend this scholarship money?
