Rosemary Collins was devoted wife, mother, and friend to many throughout Pinellas County. Collins graduated from Countryside High School in 1986, earned her Bachelor of Music Degree from the University of Southern Mississippi, and Masters in Vocal Performance from Southeastern Louisiana University. In her youth, she was selected annually for All-State choruses, played French horn in symphonic band, mellophone in marching band, sang with jazz ensemble, and thrived in various theatre programs. Her powerful soprano voice with masterful technique and artistry made her a respected singer, winning concerto competitions and lead musical roles.

Her professional teaching career spans 19 years throughout Pinellas County and includes Ponce DeLeon Elementary School, Safety Harbor Middle School, and Clearwater High School. Rosemary shared her gifts in religious communities, and accompanied many students on piano for various performances. She loved making music with her family at gatherings and both of her children inherited her talent and love of music. She leaves a beautiful legacy.

Wearing the robe of an Artist Teacher and the crown of a Servant Leaders, Rosemary tackled every challenge, crossed every bridge and climbed every mountain.
